Refund and Privacy Policy for Bnai Zion Foundation

We are committed to your privacy

Like you, Bnai Zion Foundation cares about the privacy of your information and how it is used and shared. Thank you for trusting that we will treat your data in a sensitive and sensible manner. This document explains our practices and the options you have in the way your information is collected and used by Bnai Zion Foundation. Below we will address both our online and offline privacy policies.

Please read our privacy policy carefully to get a clear understanding of how we collect, use, protect or otherwise handle your personal information when you interact with our website.

By visiting our website and sharing personal information, you agree to adhere by the practices described herein.

What personally identifiable information is collected by bnaizion.org?

Whether browsing our website or making a donation off or online, you may provide personal information (such as name, address, email, telephone, mobile and/or credit/debit card information) that you knowingly choose to disclose, to be collected for various purposes. These uses include registering for our email alerts, for events, requesting information from us about our projects, donating to us, submitting a form on our website, or simply emailing a question to us. We collect and store the information you provide on our website or give to us both online or offline. We ask for personal information so that we can satisfy your requests. This information is stored and handled in accordance with existing laws, rules and regulations. If some information is not provided, we may not be able to fulfill your request or complete your order, but you will still be free to browse most sections of our website. So, enjoy browsing our site without having to reveal personally identifiable information.



How your information is used

When information is provided by you to us for a specific purpose, the information is only used for that purpose (such as to make a donation, register for an event or receive the information you requested). We do not share your information with third parties, except as necessary to fulfill your request.

Bnai Zion Foundation does not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your personal information. If we do in the future, we will provide users with advance notice. This does not include website hosting partners and other parties who may assist us in operating our website, conducting our business, or serving our users, so long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential.

Bnai Zion Foundation will not sell, rent, give-away or share your email address or other personal information with any third party organizations. We also do not send emails on behalf of other organizations.

Should we make any material changes in the manner in which we use personally identifiable information, Bnai Zion Foundation will diligently attempt to get authorization from you. If we do change the way in which we handle personally identifiable information, it is our policy to post it 30 days prior to the change.

Data Security

Personally identifiable information is stored securely on our servers and on our donor management platforms used to handle transactions and communications. This information is only accessible to authorized personnel. To prevent unauthorized access, and proper handling of your information, we've put in place, policies and technologies to safeguard and secure the information we collect. In addition credit card numbers and other sensitive data is encrypted using SSL and is not stored on our servers.

You're in charge - Opt-in, Opt-out

If you decide to change your mind about receiving correspondence from us, we provide methods for you to Opt-out, including an auto opt-out of our mailing list (at the bottom of the email). Cookies

We currently do not use cookies on the site.

More on your information

The information that you provide us with when donating, registering for an event, etc. is only used to for the purpose intended and is not shared with third parties. However, any information that is not protected from dissemination may be publically viewable.

Some information may be stored by us to assist others who may benefit from this exchange. However, personally identifiable information will not be linked to anything published.
